23	Business	I	3	Low	Inappropriate stockpiling of hazardous materials in businesses (e.g. chemicals) and homes (e.g. fuel).
24	Business	I	3	Low	Increase in unpermitted Refuse Derived Waste sites as EU no longer accepting RDF from the UK.
25	Community Tension / Cohesion	I	3	Low	Community impact of EU Settlement Scheme / Response to continuing membership of EU.
26	Food and Water	I	3	Low	Food entering food chain is no safe to eat due to prolonged periods in transit.
27	Health	I	3	Low	Professional qualifications no longer recognised leading to workforce issues.
29	Other – Animal Welfare	I	3	Low	Shortage of animal medicines.
30	Other – LRF	I	3	Low	Category 1 and 2 responders experience business continuity issues due to disruption in the supply chain.
